We appreciate your patience and support while we all navigate these unprecedented times. These past 15 months have presented us with the most unique challenges and with your help we have been able to navigate the turbulent waters. It is with your support and dedication that we have been able to survive the COVID-19 pandemic.

With the availability of vaccines, increased sanitation measures, easement of local mandates and state guidelines, **we feel that the time is right for us to reopen our doors to the community**. The Kenworthy is committed to ensuring a safe, welcoming theatre experience to all patrons and we will continue to monitor and follow CDC and governmental mandates as they update.

Ultimately, our goal is to provide a level of transparency and openness that allows guests, renters, and staff to make informed choices about returning to our venue while not promising anything that is beyond our control. When we reopen in June we will have a number of guidelines to help you feel safe in your hometown theater.

- Seating will be limited to 60 people so proper social distance seating, as directed by the State, can be maintained;
- Due to the size of our lobby and for the comfort and safety of all guests, face coverings will be required until you are seated;
- We highly encourage you to pre-purchase your tickets online;
- We will limit the number of people in the lobby to maintain proper social distance. We may ask you to wait in the auditorium or outside of the theater until proper space is available;
- Please arrive early so we may quickly serve all guests and start the event on time.

The safety of our patrons, our staff and our community has led our decision-making as we have navigated the complications and impacts of the COVID-19 outbreak. This decision has been reached after much deliberation and in consideration of the Kenworthy's role as both a local and regional destination — and a community-gathering place.

We want to thank you and our community for sticking together and staying strong during this challenging and constantly changing time. The community we serve has always lifted us, and your support during this challenging time is deeply and particularly appreciated.
